GENERAL ORDER

In light of the amendment to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4 (m) reducing the period for effecting service from 120 days to 90 days, it is hereby

ORDERED that the amended time period for effecting service under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4 (m) shall apply to all cases filed on or after December 1, 2015, to the extent practicable, unless otherwise ordered by the presiding judge; and it is further

ORDERED that this amendment to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4 (m) shall not apply to cases already pending as of December 1, 2015, unless otherwise ordered by the presiding judge.
