This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by Ian Stewart for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that Ian Stewart, the Executive Director of the James Martin Center for Non-proliferation Studies at Middlebury College in Washington, D.C., falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Ian Stewart has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Ian Stewart shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma, to the extent such access concerns the use of the International Economic Emergency Powers Act in relation to non-proliferation and sanctions violations. Ian Stewart shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. This fee exemption applies only to Ian Stewart and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;
3. By accepting this exemption, Ian Stewart agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
4. Ian Stewart is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases; and
5. This exemption is valid until April 16, 2021.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
