This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by John Turner for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that John Turner, an LLM student at the University of Oklahoma School of Law conducting scholarly research, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, John Turner has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, John Turner shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma, to the extent such access concerns or relates to litigation between the State of Oklahoma and Native American Tribes with respect to the renewal of the parties' compacts to conduct tribal gaming. John Turner shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. This fee exemption applies only to John Turner and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;
3. By accepting this exemption, John Turner agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
4. John Turner is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases; and
5. This exemption is valid until October 28, 2020.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center at pacer@psc.uscourts.gov and to the Administrative Office of the United States Courts at Multi-CourtExemptions@ao.uscourts.gov.
