GENERAL ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED EFFECTIVE December 1, 2013:

The Clerk of the Court is directed to amend Court's Miscellaneous Order No. 03-09, filed October 15, 2003, in the matter of Division of Civil and Criminal Cases (as amended by General Order 08-01, filed March 28, 2008). Miscellaneous Order No. 03-09 divides civil filings into three categories for case assignment among the judges of this district. Additionally, Miscellaneous Order No. 03-09 provides for the division of cases among district judges in opt-out cases from the magistrate judges' original draw. See Exhibit 2 to Miscellaneous Order No. 03-09.

The assignments in category 2 remain the same. Categories 1 and 3 are amended as follows:
