This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by Eric Gelsomin (Account No. 6591176) for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that Eric Gelsomin, a Ph.D. candidate at Boston College conducting scholarly research, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Eric Gelsomin has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Eric Gelsomin shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma, to the extent such access concerns the effects of beneficial ownership in securities litigation cases filed between 2008 and 2019. Eric Gelsomin's request is further limited to securities class action lawsuits generally filed under the Securities Act of 1933 and Securities Exchange Act of 1934 involving publicly traded companies. Eric Gelsomin shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. This fee exemption applies only to Eric Gelsomin and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;
3. By accepting this exemption, Erick Gelsomin agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
4. Eric Gelsomin is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases; and
5. This exemption is valid until June 30, 2021.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center at pacer@psc.uscourts.gov and to the Administrative Office of the United States Courts at Multi-CourtExemptions@ao.uscourts.gov.
