O R D E R

IN CONSIDERATION that, LCrR 4.1(A), as approved and written, provides for the sealing of documents in criminal matters only upon the filing of a written application and for good cause shown,

AND FURTHER CONSIDERING that LCrR 4.1(A) also provides documents sealed by order of the court automatically revert to public documents at the defendant's first court appearance,

IT IS ORDERED that applications for search warrants and accompanying affidavits and search warrants shall be sealed upon filing without additional application,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applications for search warrant, affidavits and search warrants shall be deemed unsealed upon the filing of a return, demonstrating service upon the named person, entity or property,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should the United States of America wish a filed application for search warrant, affidavits and/or search warrant to remain sealed, it must file an application requesting a continuation of the seal for the Court's consideration prior to or at the time of the filing of the return.






