This Court, having undertaken the merit selection process as outlined by 28 U.S.C. § 631(b)(5) and complied with the standards and procedures set forth by the Judicial Conference of the United States, and in accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. § 631, et seq.

SO ORDERS that Jason A. Robertson is hereby appointed to serve as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge for the Eastern District of Oklahoma at the salary fixed by law or from time to time by the Judicial Conference of the United States, with his official duty station in Muskogee, Oklahoma.

Jason A. Robertson shall, upon taking the oath of affirmation as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. § 453 and 631(g) and the constitutional oath as prescribed by 5 U.S.C. § 3331, enter upon the performance of the duties as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge effective the 21st day of March 2022.

Jason A. Robertson, as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge, shall hold and discharge the duties of that office for a term of eight (8) years from the effective date of this appointment, subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 631(i), unless removed sooner under applicable law.


