GENERAL ORDER

Considering the recent amendments to Rule 16 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, which go into effect on December 1, 2022, the Court is hereby modifying the timing of the disclosure of expert witnesses in criminal cases as follows:

Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, expert-witness disclosures that must be made under Fed. R. Crim. P. 16(a)(1)(G) or (b)(1)(C) shall be made at least fourteen (14) days before pretrial conference. The party requesting expert-witness disclosures shall make timely requests for expert-witness disclosures to facilitate the opposing party's compliance with the applicable disclosure deadline.
