## GENERAL ORDER

Having been orally notified by the United States Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of Oklahoma that Congress has restored appropriations to the Department of Justice on Friday, January 25, 2019, the Court lifts the stay entered in all cases subject to General Order No. 18-13 and extends any deadline or due date in those cases for forty (40) days from the original due date. It is further ordered that in any case subject to General Order No. 18-13 in which a Rule 16 scheduling order has been entered, the dates in those scheduling orders shall remain the same.
